We do ask that you avoid taking any holidays during term times and please talk to your child/ren about the importance of them being in school. As a school we work to foster a love of reading, you can't beat reading a good book! Please promote this with your children and we believe every child should read or listen to a book at least 5 times a week outside of school and more often if possible.



# Family Action Cumbria are introducing a new course for Dads, Dads-to-be and Young Men Any Man Can

What is Any Man Can?

A 12-week early intervention group programme for Dads, Dads-to-be or young men to prevent dysfunctional or problematic behaviour from escalating to domestic violence or abuse.

This is NOT a perpetrator programme.

Who is this course suitable for?

Dads, Dads-to-be or young men who:

Are previously unknown to services for domestic abuse or violence, but behaviour is seen as problematic.

May have been involved in violence outside of the home.

May have strong beliefs about gender or be sexist.

Must accept responsibility for their own behaviour and want to improve it for themselves, their partner and/or children. They may want to be a "better Dad" or "better partner".

This is an early intervention programme, for families on Early Help Plans, new parents or parents-to-be etc.
