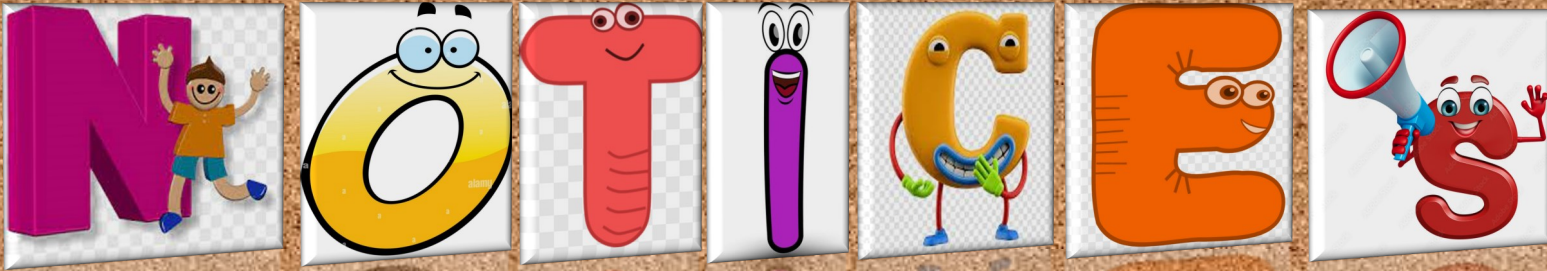

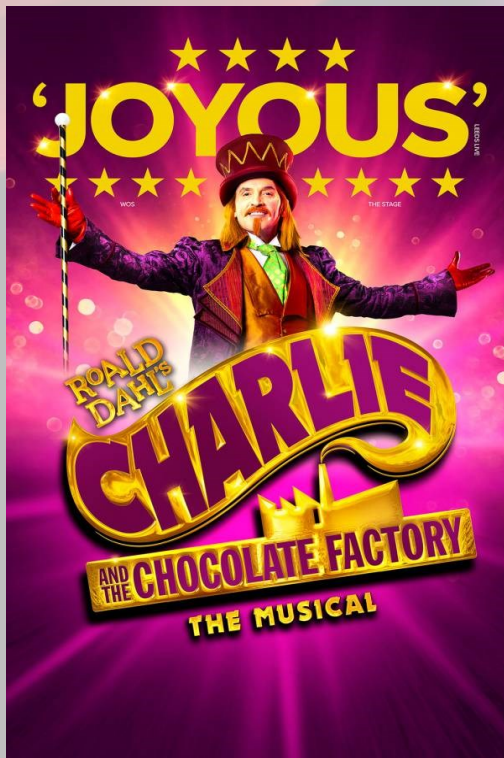

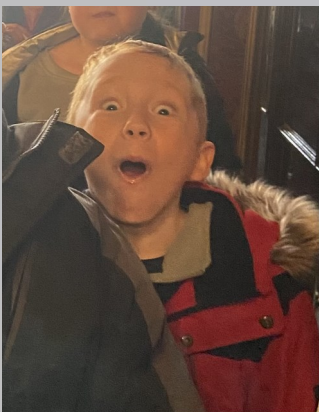




THE CHILDREN HAD THE MOST WONDERFUL TIME IN EDINBURGH ON THURSDAY.
